Personally, when I have created a contact on the slave site, I have been able to send email to the contact.

Perhaps you should have to check that the sender email adress is allowed by your hosting server. A quick review of the code show me that it uses the From email address that is defined in the Joomla Configuration. Perhaps that you have provided a value in this configuration that make your provider reject to send the email.
