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There is no limit in the number of websites.

You can have more than 1,000 websites.

If you had an error (red message), the master index is not created and the website is not recognized.

So verify that you don't have any error when creating the slave site.

You are the first that mentioned that.

If you are not able to decompress a file, this might be due to a permission error.  
Perhaps that the directory where you want decompress does not have correct permission to let you doing that.

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All the symbolic links are the one that correspond to the files and folders that are setup in the JMS template rule.

When you create a slave site, there is no file to decompress.

This is the list of files and folders that are linked (or copied) depending on the action that you have defined in the JMS template rule used to create the slave site.

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
