The Goolde Maps API key is specific per domain.

If you want to have specific key for each website, you can sometime use the Search/Replace plugin to replace a special keyword that you will decide with the appropriate value for the slave site domain or subdomain.

So that you can have several Google Maps API keys.

In general is is better to use a keyword instead of the master key to be replaced. I suspect that you didn't speeled the things correctly and that the search/replace didn't find the pattern.
