If yes, contact your hosting provider to ask him support.

If this domain is managed by another CPanel account, perhaps you have to modify it with the other CPanel account

For CPanel, I suggest you ask to the support of your hosting provider.

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Have you follow the procedure as described in FAQ <http://www.jms2win.com/faq#sec-58>

If you want to deploy website into a specific directory, you can also use the following procedure

Create a slave site into JMS  
enter a site identifier (ie demo1)  
Enter a domain. ie <http://domain.com>  
Enter deploy directory = {site\_dir}

Go in CPANEL and create AddOn domain  
Enter a new domain name = domain.com  
Document Root = public\_html/multisites/demo1
