With JMS, you can not restrict the installation of extensions but you can pre-cnfigure a website A with the extension you want and later use it in the website template A. Idem for B.

When a website is created it is still possible to install additional extensions that are alreav present in the master website.

For example, you have created a website from the template A, it will still be possible to install the forum, Virtuemart or whatever that exist on your master website.
