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I have recently used JMS to create some sites for a MLM team and they need for their affiliates to have the same products on their sites and have the ability for customers to purchase items from each individual affiate. The problem that I have for some reason, on one site alone it appears, is that when you go to the subdomain for that affiliate and navigate around the site, everthing stays within that affiliates subdomain. But, when you go to the products page (which is virtuemart) it sometimes defaults back to the master site from which it was created. The master site is a "corporate" site that contains the same virtuemart store but it has the prices turned off. The affiliate sites have the prices on, accept this one site. 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When you are on the slave site, check the VM Configuration and in particular the "secure" panel with the "SECUREURL" field.

If you have never checked and updated the VM Slave configuration, it may be possible the it uses the master VM configuration is used.

Normally, when you save the VM configuration, this create a speciifc slave VM configuration. Otherwise it uses the master VM configuration.

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Based on the extension that I have reviewed, this extension has a special installation procedure that consists in adding plenty of files into the VirtueMart directory and also adding "vm\_%" tables. There is no specific joomla extension created except a module and a plugin that is added.

As this VM Affiliate just add things in the VirtueMart then you can just use the JMS Tool menu and the "VirtueMart" component definition to automatically install the Affiliate that is included in VirtueMart.

Concerning the additional module and plugin, you can just define them.  
We will add their definition in a next release of JMS Multisites patches.
