But there is a problem, when the upload ends the system detect the version 1.7.1 installed and it doesn't upgrade the linked tables of the slave site... how can i do that?

When and extension perform an upgrade or a migration, normally, you have to re-install it into each

slave site to let the extension proceed its specific upgrade or migration processing.

So, try to re-install Kunena from the back-end of the slave site.

I tried but it says kunena is already at 1.7.1 version so it doesnt give me the screen where i can click on upgrade button (and so upgrade the linked tables). How can i solve that?

Immediatelly like that, I don't know.

The only idea that I have immediately is to restore a old Kunena files in the component directory to let the Kunena imagine this is an upgrade.

Perhaps it use the version number that is present in the "kunena.xml" and that if you change the version number this will help you upgrade.

Perhaps you could post a request in Kunena support to ask them how to proceed with the upgrade in this case.

Ok, the version is inside the db in the row kunena version, i tried to delete the row with 1.7.1 but the installation on the slave site continue to detect the version 1.7.1 installed and it didnt go for the db

I'm asking in the kunena forum how can i deceive the installer to procede with db upgrade.

I know that Kunena store the version number in the DB but it should have different version number in the slave site when they are still not upgraded.

I suppose that you change the number in the master that is incorrect as normally this is the version present in the slave site that is read by kunena.

So you have effectively to contact kunena to identify how to upgrade as it seems there is something else that does not trigger the upgrade.

I solved the kunena upgrade issue using these steps:

- 1) from jms control panel, I uninstalled kunena from slave sites
- 2) I upgraded kunena on the master site with joomla package
- 3) from the ims control panel, I installed again kunena on the slave sites (in shared mode as before)

Unfortunately it is not possible to upgrade kunena database from the slave site as you described in the guides
