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If I understand well, you want to have 2 domain names ([www.mysite.com](http://www.mysite.com) and [www.hissite.com](http://www.hissite.com)) that share the same website.

If this is the case, I think you don't need JMS.

You just have to update your hosting server that make both domain as synonyms.
