If the front page slide show seems to save the images in the "/media" directory. Therefore, if this directory is shared between the websites, you will share the images between the websites.
Perhaps you should have to create a copy of the "/media" directory.

Should I also do this for shGroupDomain if the above is correct?

Becarefull that once you will have performed a copy, you will have to maintain the content of this directory "manually". So if you install other extension that are storing subdirectories, you will have to "synchronize" them.
