| In Joomla 2.5.10, they have modified the Joomla installer and created a regression issue that we have reported to Joomla. |
| If you want to install a JMS 1.2.97 on a J2.5.10 or higher, you need to rollback manually a change that they did in joomla. See Joomla bugtracker 30206 http://joomlacode.org/gf/project/joomla/tracker/?action=TrackerItemEdit&tracker_item_id=30206 |
| We have fixed that in the JMS 1.3.10 and rollback (discard) the change done by Joomla. As JMS 1.2.x is no more updated, you will need to rollback the update manually. |
| Otherwise, this should theorically work on pre-installed JMS 1.2.x on a J2.5.9 or lower. |
