The only thing that can be done is either create a website with the pre-defined menu that will be later replicated at the creation of other websites.	٢
The other solution consists in using the "Multi Sites Menu Item" that allow accessing menu that are already defined in other websites. Once you have created a menu item, you can change its definition the other websites and their update will be taken into account by all the Multi Sites Menu Item that reference the menu item.	າ in
