- You have to check that you have correctly enabled the editor (I suppose Yes)
- Check that you have installed the JCE 154 plugin (I think YES)

---

- Check that you have the JCE Group Layout defined (I suppose NO) - This is the place where you define all the button that must be displayed. So go in the JCE back-end of the slave and check the groups.
