The concept consist in the definition of the replication rule in JMS template and after that use this rule when you create the slave site.

Here it is a sample that will create a slave1 website that is a copy of your master website

Create a JMS template Template ID = replic master Select the template site = master db

You can also pre-configured the other parameters like the domain, new table prefix, deploy directory.

Once the template is create, you just have to use it when you create a slave site Site ID = slave1 Domain = {site url}/multisites/{site id} Template = replic_master New DB prefix = {site id}

Deploy directory = {site dir}

I have already replied to the same question in the forum.

So you should find other reply concerning the way to clone the master website.
