I have replied several time the procedure that I use personnally for the backup / restore

For the DB, I use PHPMyAdmin (export / export) to Backup / restore the DB. It works correctly and also perform a correct backup of the view.

For the files, I use a unix command from a SSH termin tar -cvf this backup (C)reate (V)erbous (F)ilename tar -xvf this restore e(X)tract (V)erbous (F)ilename

This will create tar file that you can compress with gzip
