My master site is in: /home/mydomain/public html/ My slave site is in : /home/mydomain/public html/services/baseline

I am trying to create another slave site from the baseline Administrator panel that will reside in: /home/mydomain/public html/services/sitenumberone

But the JFTP layer is failing. Can I not do this because the new slave-slave site will be below the root level of the initial slave/cookie-cutter site?

If not, can you offer a possible fix to accomplish what I'm looking for?
