YES this is possible for a limited number of extensions. When you share extension, JMS use a MySQL feature to share the table and avoid dupliaction of information.

Most of the extension that can be share require also to share the joomla users. The sharing is a decision that is taken when you create the slave site and that can not be modified later. This impact the way that the DB tables are created.
