Part of the articles should be replicated to news category on slave site 1 and part to news category on slave site 2 Is this possible with JMS and Article sharing? If not what's the best way to do this in your opinion? May I solve the problem creating in master site 2 categories news slave 1 and news slave 2. Copying articles from news to e.g. "news\_slave\_1" and using Article sharing to publish this in the slave\_1 website? Are there better ways? Thanks. The key element is to structure the articles to be easy to display from the other site. For example you could create on your master a section "new" in which you create category for all the news relative for slave 1, another category for slave 2, ... In the slave site, you could say display all the articles present in the master / section news / category X That all.

This is mainly a question of organisation.
