There is nothing public.

In fact VirtueMart save plenty of parameters into it "virtuemart.cfg.php" file that is manage by the "configuration" but the "shop image" directory is not part of the user interface.

Perhaps you can experiment yourself to change manually the internal "virtuemart.cfg" file to modify all the entries relative to the "shop image".

It is not guaranted that it will work because perhaps there are some other sources if they hardcoded the directory name but we think it should work.
