Concerning JomSocial 1.8, YES

Concerning Kunena 1.6 they have changed the table name they are using and we will add the new definition in a next release. , normally YES - the latest that we retested was 1.5

In the meantime, you can re-install the extension directly in the slave site.

There is no limit to have the update on a same version of a product. For example all the JMS 1.2.x. So as long as we do not create a new JMS 1.3.x, you can update it.

Concerning the upgrade (ie 1.2.x to 1.3.x) you will have to buy the new version. When we release a new version of a product, we send email with discount coupon to give the customer upgrade with a lower price.

We have several products that are updated for more than 1 year (ie. JMS Multisites, Article Sharing)
