The template has seven different backgrounds params.ini configurability from the file, but if I use the special copy I can not configure it, because it changes the background as the template. I am forced to copy the template on each slave! How can I fix without having to copy the template on each slave?

If you are using Templates that are using standard joomla processing, the "params.ini" files become specific to each slave site event when you use the "special copy" of the templates directory.

By default, when a "params_{site_id}.ini" file does not exists, it read the "params.ini" file that is the master one.

Some templates company may have created specific framework that bypass the standard joomla processing and that miight read the "params.ini" file instead of the "params_{site_id}.ini" file.

So this repends of the template that you are using.

I try with the template standard "rhuk_milkyway" but i have the same problem. How do i read the new file with the new extension params_site id.ini ? Sorry for my bad english, i'm italian...
