Yes it could be a plugin but I have preferred a module to be able choose the position where to include the code.

The old Google Analytics code was preferred in the bottom of the page (or the debug position).

Now the new google code is preferred in the top of the page or header.

In addition, this give the possibility to include several Google Analytics in the same page with different codes. With a plugin, you can enter the code only once.

So you see that you have several advantages to have the Google Analytics defined as a module instead of a plugin.

Multi Sites Google Analytics is a free module for Joomla 1.5 and 1.6 that allows you add into your website the Google Analytics script code.

With this joomla module, you can assign different Google Analytics Tracker Identifier (UA-0000000-0) to different domain name. You can also assign a default identifier that will be used any domain name. This Joomla Module is very suitable when you host multiple domain name to the same Joomla website. This module is also works with Joomla Multi Sites.
