The users can register in slave1.domain.com to have access to the slave2.domain.com or

www.domain.com or simply domain.com. In fact this will share the \*.domain.com and you can login on any subdomains.

With Joomla 1.6, you can choose the domain part that must be considered as shared between the websites. This is a new parameter introduced by Joomla in its Global Configuration (see cookie domains).

In Joomla 1.5, this is Jms Multisite that compute the value and make the \*.domain.com common between the websites subdomains.
