- 1) Yes you can install Jms Multisites on an existing website and convert it as a master website.
- 2) It is possible to share the users with CB 1.4 between websites.

The single sign-in (remain logged between website) is also possible when using the same domain. So you can have website with different subdomain or subdirectories that use the same domain. In your sample, the domains are different. So you can share the users but not benefit of the single sign-in.
