Yes this is possible.

If you also want to benefit of the single sign-in, the "shared" user must be on the same domain.

So you can share the users accross websites but if you want that your users benefit of a single sign-in, it is required that you different websites are using the same domain (ie. xyz.domain.com)

If the users are not on the same domain, you can share the users information between websites but the users will have to re-login with the same user and password.
