I explain what I need to do with it. I'm asking teh support to help me out.

I have 1 joomla 1.5 site with several users and lots of sobi2 entries. I want to use all of it with a different template in another domain.

If a user who loged in the firts site and create an entry it sould appear automatically in the second site, so it's very important to using the same database (with same prefixes) for the users and the content.

That is what multisite means to me (not only useless hosting space saving), and that is what I have seen in the jms multisite video spot.

Please help me or send me a tutorial to learn how to do this.

You will have to create a JMS Templates rules where you will select the "template site" that must be copied and with which the users and sobi2 will be shared. In the "sharing" tabs, you will have to select the "joomla users" and the "sobi2" extension as shared.
