Before unzip the joomla distribution, rename the existing "/installation" into "/installation jms".

Unzip the joomla.tar.gz or joomla.zip

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Rename the "/installation" into "/installation\_original"

Login in the back-end of the master (/administrator/index.php)

Go in JMS and re-install the patches

When done, you have a new "/installation" directory restored.

Remove or rename this one to re-use the original one (in case you have a specific language version - not the english one).

Rename "/installation" into "/installation\_jms25"

Rename "/installation\_original" into "/installation"

When done, return in JMS patches to install the patch into the "installation".

After that, go in the new "extension manager" / database checking and fix the DB layout.

Repeat the "extension maanager" / database / fix for each slave sites.

After that, you should have all your websites updated with Joomla 2.5 and the new database layout.

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
