The concept of JMS is to share the same Joomla installation PHP code files and folders.  
So joomla is present only once for all the websites and the patches are installed in the single joomla.

So all the websites must be on the same server.

We need:  
To Create a new multisite remotely from [xyzbillingsupport.com](http://xyzbillingsupport.com)

However, the master and the slave sites will both be on xyzmultisitessetup.com but we just need the replication process to be remote.

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I don't undertand what you are trying to do.

The concept of JMS is to share the same Joomla installation (the same files and folders on the disk).

So try creating a slave site remotely will break the assumption that you have the slave site and master website on the same server and that you are using the Symbolic Link to share the files and folders.

Your sample with "createsite.php" does not exist and can not work.

You have to use the JMS component to build the slave site.
