I don't know how you expect to create the google map but if this is a module that you do that, you could disable the module in the slave site after that you have created it.

If this is a specific code that you add for example into a custom HTML then you could modify the custom HTML in the slave site after that you have copied it.

ShareMasterMultisites only share the joomla users and not the other content.  
So you should be able to change the slave site content once it is created.

Another trick is also to use a keyword instead of the google map code.

In this case, you could use the Search/Replace plugin that is available in free download  
[https://www.jms2win.com/en/component/docman/doc\\_details/13-search--replace-utility](https://www.jms2win.com/en/component/docman/doc_details/13-search--replace-utility)  
to create a customized Search/Replace file depending on the website.

So that, in certain site, you could have a different replace value depending on the Site ID.
