First I have noticed that in media and images, you have used absolute path that is WRONG. you can use {rel site dir} but in your case, as you have deployed the slave site into a specific directory (deploy dir = {site dir}, you probably want to provide media and image (without the {site dir}.

Concerning the templates folder, you can check how it is created in the "{site dir}/templates". Normally, this must be a physical directory in which you have several symbolic link to the master templates.

By default JMS create a specific "templates" directory in which it create Symbolic Link to the original directory.

As explained in the user manual, you can at this moment delete the link to replace them with a physical copy.

This can be do in the slave site administration with the "un-install" of the template and re-install of a copy.

- Check that you don't already have this directory physically present (not a symbolic link).

- If you already have a symbolic link, check that the redirection is the same.

- If there is no "multisites" directory present in you deploy folder, check that you have permission to access the]/var/www/html/multisites]. Maybe it is protected (try a chmod 777) to see if this is a permission issue.

In you video, it is show that multisites directory is own by the root and you request later to create a link with a "apaches" user.

Check the owner of the directory.

As you have a "normal" apaches users, it has not enough permission to create the link on the "root" multisites directory present in your master website.

If you have a look in the /multisites/xxxx directory you probably see that files are created by the apaches.

You may also try to increase the permission of the /multisites/xxxx with 777

but your problem is that you have a mixt between apaches user and root user. This is normal that apaches can not access or modify the files and folders that are own by the root.

This is a permission problem but I don't know where if you have the same group, owner, 777, ...

If your apaches is not allowed to creazte ""Unable to create the symbolic link -> ." this is a permission problem.

If all the directories have 777 and same owner, this should work. I suppose there is a permission that is still not correct in a directory.

First in your video, there are inconsistencies between the "domain URL" and the deploy folder. In the domain you specify the {site_url}/{site_id} and in the deploy folder you specify the equivalent of {site_url}/multisites/{site_id} that is not the same.

I suspect that all your problem comes from the fact that URL and location on the disk is not consistent. See video present in the tutorial step 22

For the /administrator/templates, this is not possible because to do that this suppose that the /administrator is NOT a link but a reall directory like I did it for the front-end.

The only solution is to create many /administratrator/templates/xxxx directories. Where xxx is the template. In general, you can duplicate such templates sub-directories to allows you change its content

NO this is not possible.

The back-end has the /administrator directory that is a symbolic link and the objective it not to replicate all the Joomla PHP code for each website.

Create what you request mean that all the directory structure of the administration directory should be replicated in each website and each time you install an extension and so on for all the website.

This is not available and the objective also is not to modify joomla itself to change the way they manage the templates.

Sorry but I have no solution for that.
