If you have a problem on writing a file, you have to check the permission on the files and folder.

The permission are not the one that you specify in the DB.

This is the permission is the "unix or windows" permission.

Perhaps you can try modifying the permission for the "...multisites/xxx" directory.

This can be modified in the "multisites.cfg.php" files as documented in page 14 of the user manual.

Change the chmod from 0755 to 0777.

Concerning the email that is returned, perhaps you are using a smtp sender using "dynamic ip" address.

Our hosting provider only accept official sender using static IP address that can be identified.
