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If you want to share an extension, you need that it is define in Joomla.

So you need to install and create (link) the MySQL tables for this extension otherwise the extension will not be known by joomla like you have not installed it.

As explained the sharing of an extension consists in sharing of MySQL tables.

So if you install (not shared) an extension into a slave site, it will have its own MySQL table that you can see with the JMS tools (table tab).

If you decide to create a slave site that share the extension the you will see that MySQL table will be a link to another website (the one that physically contain the table).

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
