I had everything working with a mastersite ([www.aamembers.org.nz](http://www.aamembers.org.nz)) and two subsites using subdomains. Then I deleted the subdomain so as to set up the Add On domain name to be one of the subsites.

Once creating the add on domain ([aaconvention.org.nz](http://aaconvention.org.nz) - [convention.aamembers.org.nz](http://convention.aamembers.org.nz)) I checked the settings for urls for this subsite:

However now the default page for <http://aaconvention.org.nz> is going to the default hosting page rather than <http://aaconvention.org.nz/home> or <http://aaconvention.org.nz/index.php>

Do you know why this would be?

I copied over the .htaccess as part of subdomain process and had tested the whole thing with another random domain name earlier which worked but I am not sure what has changed apart from using a different addon domain name.
