When there is a link on the multisites directory, it can be normal to have an infinite recursion loop.
To avoid the loop, you can deploy the slave site into a directory beside the master.
If you don't setup a JMS Template that define the directories that must be "symbolic link" and ignored. Perhaps you could "ignore" the slave1 directory

Ignore mean that you don't want to have the directory created in the slave site. Symbolic Link means that you want to have a link in the slave site directory that point to the same "physical" directory present in the master website.

This allow you to control the new directory structure of your slave site.
