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If you are deploying the slave sites into a directory beside the master or in a totally different directory, you may have to open some security depending on your environment and hosting.

If you are using Plesk or Direct Admin or similar HTTP Server administration tool, perhaps you have to also check the open\_basedir parameter that may restrict the access of the directory (even when 777 is put on the directory).

On Windows platform, you may also have to check the security relative to the directories.

Also check the parent directories.

As you mentioned it with your "demo2" test, this is a permission problem that must be solved by the administrator of this server (or you if you are the administrator).

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
