It's a thing that generaly occurs when I submit the dates I entered previously in the mask under "New DB Server name:". For Example in the template mask. After the dates are submitted into the Data Base the expression "localhost" ist converted into the IP adress of the server. So, the dedicated Host for the database and the user permissions get the Server IP instead of localhost. And that doesn't work.

This is not the "template" screen but the "manage sites" detail screen. It seems that you are using a rule that I can not really read. Can you give the screenshot of the "template" rule that you selected in the "template" field.

I will try reproducing it but it but for the moment it seems that in your "template" rule, there is almost nothing. No DB parameters. Perhaps you just have selected the master DB but I don't see it.

That's right. I do not have any rules defined. But what shall be the difference? Whether I define the rules before in the template or if I do that manually in the manage site detail screen. The result is the same. The expression localhost that will be needed as standard term in the DB are not be generated. I get the Server IP instead.

Till that everything are generated without problems: the DB user, the DB itself, the DB password. Only the hostname that is needed for permissions is wrong.
