

## Site Manager icon: new extension present

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On my master site, I select Components > Multisites > Manage Sites (Site Manager). Many slave sites have an icon next to the ID with a popup: "New extension present...". I select the slave site, select Edit, make a small change, Save. Two things happen:

1) Site Details: "Warning: Invalid argument supplied for foreach() in /home/xxx/domains/xxx.com/subdomains/master/public\_html/administrator/components/com\_multisites/helpers/helper.php on line 603"

2) The ID icon does not go away.

Are these problems related?

How can I make the ID icon go away?

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Are you managing JMS from the master website or from a slave site.  
Normally JMS should only managed from the master website.

It seems that you are working from a slave site and that you don't have the "/multisites" directory shared 'Symbolic Link'

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I am working from the master site "MA MASTER".

Website template Details > Folders and Files > "multisites" says "SL: Symbolic Link".

Also, I see on MA MASTER Site Manager that one of the slave "Prefix" is "jos\_". Is that a problem?

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If this is not a slave site but the master website, the "/multisites" directory exists.

So you don't have to go in any JMS template rule as you are on the master website and not on a slave site.

This seems inconsistent with the description of the error that let suppose that this occurs on a slave site that does not has the "multisites" directory.

All I can suggest is to cross-check again.

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## Re: Site Manager icon: new extension present

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The "refresh icon" is displayed when the number of table (count) is not the same between 2 websites.

Use the JMS Tool menu and select the website that correspond to the website that you want to cross-check. In the "table" tab, you will find all the tables and links of the website.

Somewhere in the list, you will have a difference. Perhaps that you have additional table in the slave site that are not present in the other website.

This might be the case when you uninstall something in the master before that you uninstall in the slave site.

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
