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Hi Edwin,

sorry for delay, but:

1 - I waited the new Seblod 2.0 release (now here attached) pkg\_seblod2\_rc1.zip

2 - I noted you rebuild the list of extensions currently defined in JMS (well done) where the "old" jSeblod CCK is listed as "install".

So, now, my question is more detailed:

Thinking on Joomla 1.6.x and new Seblod 2.0 I want build a portal (my JMS master) where develop some services (using Seblod).

So, for example, I develop a Real Estate form and customer login into my portal and add/public his advices (Joomla articles + Seblod).

At the mean time his advices are published on his site (one of my JMS slave).

Well, if I understood, this can be done "sharing the users" and using the "Articles sharing" component (my be I have to wait the Joomla 1.6 version, where probably will be added the all the ACL functions, so the ability to share articles depending on author id, group, ACL level etc.)

What I'm missing is if Sharing articles I will share also the Seblod forms etc. build on the portal (master).

If I'm right, the questions are:

1 - When can we expect an "Articles sharing" for Joomla 1.6 release ?

2 - Can I share Seblod 2.0 ?

In May (and/or when "Article Sharing for JMS" compatible with Joomla 1.6 will be available):

joomla 1.6.x + JMS + SEBLOD 2.0 + Article Sharing for JMS

= I can share Joomla 1.6 articles "designed" with new SEBLOD 2.0

Is it right?

Please, Can you confirm that I understand it?

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Yes you can use the Joomla Article and SeBlod but can not be shared.

No we will not develop a version of the Article Sharing for Joomla that will work with SeBlod.

We are developing the same version that you have for Joomla 1.5 but for 1.6 - So no SeBlod.

What you request is the development of a multisites seblod.

So the final answer is that you can NOT share seblod.

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So, right now, can NOT share SEBLOD. But:

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One year ago, I had contact with SeBlod team and give them Jms Multi Sites to allow them create a multisites SeBlod.

So for the moment, I don't have any solution for you.

Concerning forms, the simpliest and the one that can be shared and also for which we have possibility to create partial sharing is ck\_forms.

The partial sharing require specific support to modify the extension at each new version of the ck\_forms but this is possible. The latest time we modified it is for the ck\_form 1.3.3 b5

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Well, in first (I think is clear) I'm asking you because I believe JMS is a must for any Joomla user, so, really, many thanks for answers.

At the mean time I believe CCK features is a must for Joomla.

SEBLOD 2.0 seem to be really part of Joomla because its Universal and can work with all the Extension like Hika Shop / Virtuemart etc.

Now, I'm looking to find a solution for our project, but for it I'm trying to understand what is situation (I'm not a programmer).

If you had contact with Seblod team one year ago I think that technically the "JMS compatibility" cannot be solved working on JMS and/or some JMS components, but only working on SEBLOD, am I right? So, if I have: Joomla 1.6 + JMS + SEBLOD 2.0 + Hika Shop, and use SEBLOD for add/modify Hika Shop page products, these cannot be shared also if Hika Shop lonely can be shared with JMS. Right ?
