This extension is not yet defined in the JMS Tool menu and we didn't review it. So it is difficult for us to give you an answer.

When an extension is not defined in the JMS tool menu, you can re-install it into the slave site to let joomla add the definition into the DB.

In Joomla 1.7, you can also use the "dicover" function present in the "extension manager"
