The error is due to the JATabs system plugin that enter in conflict when rendering a shared article. The JATabs declare a joomla article instead of a shared article when the page to render is a shared article.

Disable the JATabs system plugin resolved the rendering of the shared article.

JATabs must be fixed as following. If the page to render is a "com\_multisitecontent" then use the multisitescontent Otherwise, use the normal com content.
