JMS 1.2.97 is not qualified to be installed on Joomla 2.5.10 or higher.

You need the JMS 1.3.10 or higher to be able working on Joomla 2.5.10 or higher.

This is a regression bug introduced in the Joomla 2.5.10 that have changed their installer for the Red Shop component.

If you have purchased a JMS 1.2.x, it is clearly show that it only works on Joomla 5.5.9 or lower. A read

message warn you for that. On some browser, this red message is also blinking to warn the visitor.

To make JMS 1.2.x working on joomla 2.5.10 or higher, see the bugtracker and rollback the change performed by joomla.

OR you can upgrade to JMS 1.3.x with the discount coupon that we have sent to you as you just have purchased JMS 1.2.x.

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
