Dear Liliam,

The reason is explain in the MySQL error message

command denied to user 'mercadoa geral'@'localhost'

This mean that your MySQL user mercadoa geral does not have the permission to share tables using CREATE VIEW.

On which hosting provider are you hosted? Do you use cPanel?

The hosting companies that use cPanel may have a problem due to a bug in cPanel to does not set the ALL PRIVILEGES to the MySQL users that are created.

If you host your how server, you can grant the user permission with the PHPMyAdmin.

Depending on the hosting provider, you may contact their support to grant your MySQL to give the privileges.

For example if you are hosted at HostGator with shared server, you can send them a message to the support and they will grant you the user to allow sharing tables.

There is nothing else.

You can copy past the SQL statement and try manually.

The error is definitivelly a permission issue and you have to grant the MySQL user with correct privileges.

This probably means that your hosting provider has not correctly grant your user OR that you are using another MySQL user.

Your hosting provider not only have to grant your user but perhaps also define for which DB this user may be autorized.

I don't know how your hosting provider configure the MySQL users and their privileges.

Dear Liliam,

the problem is definitively a problem with MySQL user permission.

Give to the MySQL administrator the guery that you try to execute and ask him to provide you a MySQL user that have the privilege to perform the action.

The SQL statement is present in the error is reported.

Give him the CREATE VIEW error with the permission denied to the user.

Or ask him a root MySQL login that will have all the permission on everything and any DBs. If you receive the MySQL root login, see the user manual for the procedure to provide it to jms. It consists in the edition of the multisites.cfg.php file.

Your problem is like you receive a user login that can not create some kind of files. So ask to the administrator to grant your MySQL user with the privilege to do the operation.

Ask them to try execute the statement that return the error to allow them check the privileges

They must be logged with your user and password.

This will allow them check the privileges.

JMS when it tries grant a user to a specific table, it uses a statement slightly different to the one used by your admin.

It contains the GRANT OPTION at the end.

Hi

I have had this issue too. I use Cpanel, so I asked my host to check MySQL user permissions. The host support tell me that the MySQL user permissions are fine. SO I'm stuck again.

I was able to create a new site 'slavemaster' using multisites without a template (copy from master) then the installer process ran and created all the tables.

I have then used 'slavemaster' site to create a template for the slave sites, per your tutorial video on

"User Sharing".

But when I try to create the new slave site from the template, it spits the error as above and does not create tables for the new slave site. I'm using one database for the master, then a second database for the slavemaster (table prefix slavemaster) and all the resulting slave sites (prefix sslave1).

Can you please give me any more tips? Or do you need more info to diagnose?
