Hey! I have installed JMS and Article Sharing and have set up a template that replicates my site into a new domain name (i won't go too far into the nitty gritty of it)

However, in the new website, my menu items that link JMS articles (Multi Sites Article Layout) get lost and I have to re-set up the menu items. They still exist with the correct name, it's just that when I edit the menu item I have to reselect the Multi Sites Article Layout as it's type, or else I get a helper.php error on Line 112 (i think).

It is not a huge issue because I can just fix the menu items each time, however it may warrant looking into as it would also save me a lot of time :)
