

MultiSites menu entries try to download index.php

I installed JMS 1.2.33 in Joomla 1.6 Beta5 and it shows a successful installation.

Then when I go to Administration | Components | Multi Sites and click on any menu entry I get a popup window asking me to download 'index.php'. It's like there is some type of mime error.

Trying to download yields a 0 byte file.

The only error in the error_log is:
Cannot redeclare class jcachecontroller

Not sure what that error is but the rest of my sites all seem to be working without any problem.

Perhaps you have to check the permission to understand why it is a zero byte.

Is this a link ?

The administrator/index.php file was not 0 bytes. But, MultiSites was trying to download index.php as a

0 byte file.

I finally fixed this problem by restarting apache.

Now I can get to the Manage Sites page and install the patches.

With the patches installed everything looks like it works except for the Layouts. It causes this error:

YES the layout menu is still not work and will not work yet in JMS 1.2.35 that we will release soon. We have not yet found how to have something compatible between Joomla 1.5 and 1.6 for this part. You can use the layout in the front-end but you can not install additional layout in 1.6. As we have not yet published additional layout, we given a lower priority to this part.

I remember you that we still consider JMS 1.2.34 as an alpha for Joomla 1.6.

See the release note that mention what is supposed working correctly.
