I didn't yet found which is the problem.

All I can tell you is that they change their algorithm and that the remaining file that we patch concern a patch that should be replace by a new implement that sh404sef have to implement if they want to be consistent in their implementation between the back-end and the front-end.

Their new algorithm compute the cache in the back-end based on the "live url" parameter and in the front-end is an hardcoded cache name (the old name).

So if you are not happy with their latest sh404sef version, I suggest that you use an older one (ie. 2.0.3)
