I suspect that you have created a slave site that is sharing the CB users with another website. I suspect that the other website that physically contain the CB users has added custom fields (perhaps 'friends').

If I am correct, when you create the "slave2" website, the "friend" field was not present in CB. MySQL save the table layout when sharing a table.

As you have shared the CB content, you can just "uninstall" the CB extension in Slave2 and "re-Share" the extension in Slave2.

Use the JMS Tool menu for that.

This will rebuild the MySQL colomn snapshot that is saved when creating the link between the websites.
