As you can read several times in the forum, this is the symptom that your server has probably a limitation to upload huge pacakge.

JMS is almost 4MB and your server must accept to upload such size that does not seems the case. See the tutorial video 3 that gives an alternative solution to install from a directory http://www.jms2win.com/en/tutorial#jms12x-3

In case of Joomla 1.6 or 1.7, you have to use the subdirectory j16 to get the manifest file for the joomla 1.6 or 1.7
