I have the Article Sharing plugin installed, and wish to update the articles on my slave sites from the master site.

When I use the Tools and go to com content and click "propagate to children" and "overwrite," then hit execute, I get the following error:

I think that you make confision between the "Article Sharing for JMS" extension and the functionality that consists in the JMS tool to overwrite the content of an extension.

The "Article Sharing for JMS" does NOT own any content.

The content is the joomla article content and the "Article Sharing for JMS" directly read the other DB to get the articles.

So you can use the "overwrite" functionality for the "Article Sharing for JMS" as there is not content to update.

On which Joomla version do you have this error message reported? Do you have that with Joomla 1.5 or 1.7 or 2.5?

I suppose that you are working on Joomla 1.5.
