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Hi again, regarding the Article Sharing for Joomla 3.1, there are some bugs.

Scenario:

1.  
On Slave-site > Create menulitem -> Select "Article Sharing" > Single Article
2.  
Select site\* = is selected (only the articles from slave-site is shown) BUT if I select again I find related articles > I Selected articleID 43 for example from

3. When I save, the article CHANGES to the article 43 from the SLAVE-site, not so good.

My home made solution:

1.  
Turn of all SEO in Global panel
  
2.  
Do the steps 1-3 above, and then copy "Link"
  
3.  
Change the menuitem to "URL" and paste in the link

This works BUT :( I'm looking forward too a real solution.

I have noticed and will try reproducing it.

Based on what I have understood, you mentioned that when you select the "master" site from a slave site, the site\_id field would not be present in the menu item link and that in fact this is the article from the current site (here the slave) that is displayed.

If the menu item link is correct and the site\_id and article id is correct, can you tell me exactly which is your SEF setting inside joomla.

Do you use SEF with the rewrite mode = YES or NO ?

If you just use the SEF without the rewrite mode, there is a bug in joomla that I need to report and is not related to the article sharing.

If you disable the SEF or use the SEF with rewrite mode = ON this should work.

Hi, I'm back (unfortunately :( )

Now I'm using:

Joomla 3.6.2

JMS Multisite 1.3.59 BASIC

Patches difinition version 1.3.54

I've got 1 master and 7 slave sites.

From MASTER I've used "Tools -> Multi Sites Article Sharing" and "Install from master" to slave site 1

Now the problem on slave site 1:

Menu -> Add Menu Item -> Multi Sites Article Layout

When I select I only get the articles from slave site 1 and I get this jquery-error in the consol: Uncaught TypeError: Cannot read property 'getAttribute' of null which referes to this line: var href = elt.getAttribute("href");

Any ideas?

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I am able to reproduce it.

This seems to be a bug that is araised with Joomla 3.4 and higher.

Modification in the Article Sharing is therefore required to be compatible with J3.4 and higher. This will take a little time.

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A partial fix is available in the Article Sharing version 1.3.08 that fix the JavaScript error under Joomla 3.4 and higher.

Temporary workarround to create a new menu item using the "Multisites single Article Layout".

Ensure that you have at least one article in your current site.

When creating the menu item "Multisites single Article Layout", you can select the "Site ID" but the "Select Article" does not show any articles.

Click on the search icon that displays the article from the CURRENT site (Not the selected site). That is BAD but give you the possiblity to provide an ID that is mandatory to save the menu item.

Select any article to have an article ID and save your menu.

Re-open the menu item and now you will be able to see the list of the article for the selected site ID.

Do not use the Search filter as it display the current site article ids.

If you enter something in the filter, you have to close the modal (popup) window and re-open it to have the value filtered on the appropriate Site ID.
