You can register a domain anywhere and just declare the name server of you web-hosting or in some cases, just change the DNS / A-record to give the IP of the hosting server. In gneeral, it is better and easier to update the "name server" to let the new hosting environment manage the DNS records for you and not have to manage them manually.
