We want it where if someone posts on either site that the post will also be on the other. Is this possible with this extension? Do I need this extension to do it or can I just create the new site and rename the database to my current one? Thanks for any help.

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The concept of JMS is based on the sharing.

- Sharing of the same Joomla application (php code)
- Sharing of the content of a limited number of extensions (DB content).

See the list of extensions that are currently defined in the JMS Tools menu and also the one that can have their content shared.

JomSocial is an extension that can have its content shared.

The sharing of the content of an extension consists in the sharing of the MySQL tables used by this extension.

In other words, the record (data) are unique and not duplicated (as they are shared by MySQL)

It is also possible to share the content of JomSocial between different DBs.

Remark: This share the whole content of JomSocial.

If you want a partial sharing of the JomSocial, this is not possible.

Doing such partial sharing require that the author modify their code to provide for example group of users per websites or event or community, ...

If you need such partial sharing, today, you have EasySocial that implemented such kind of partial sharing when JMS is present.

So that, you can create subset of users depending on the website.

JMS Basic is enough to do that.

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I want the same Jomsocial content and users but a different template and Joomla installation. My main issue now is when someone signs up with the app I want them to get an email from that site and not the main site. If they sign up on the main site then they get the main site email. Will JMS allow for that?

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No problem with JMS to have websites with different look (joomla template).  
See for example [www.jms2win.com](http://www.jms2win.com) and [meeting2win.com](http://meeting2win.com)  
There are 2 different domains with different look.  
Both are slave sites and sharing the users.

See also [www.mywebsite2win.com](http://www.mywebsite2win.com) that is a portal with several slave site with different look.

When a user create an account in a website, the confirmation email is generally sent using the infos of the website where it is created.

I think this is also the case of JomSocial that use the "configuration.php" mail info for sending the confirmation email.

If not, for your information, it is possible to share JomSocial except its configuration. So if the "sender email" address is located in the JomSocial configuration, you can have different one.

What you are describing is NOT really related to JMS but related on the place where JomSocial reads the "sender email" to the signup.

JMS does NOT touch to the way that the extension are working.

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To share the content of an extension this is done at the moment that the website is copied.  
Instead of copy a MySQL table, we create a link of on the MySQL table.

Therefore, the sharing is an operation that is only done when duplicating a website and not while creating a fresh slave site that by definition (fresh) is disconnected from the other site.

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You can always buy our billable support to help you doing setup, install, uninstall, training or even develop specific things.

A "blank page" is generally due to a php fatal error.  
Check if you have an "error\_log" file with more detail on what may cause this potential "php fatal" error.

Theoretically, JMS should only have to be installed on the master website and is not required in the slave site.

The only case where JMS can be installed in a slave site is in the case of a website creation from the front-end of a slave site. (Case of JMS full).

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
